The Board of the Marquette Neighborhood Association (MNA) is contacting you concerning the proposal by the owners of El Dorado Grill at 744 Williamson to formalize and redesign their outdoor eating area.

At its meeting of April 11, the Preservation & Development Committee of MNA unanimously approved, and on April 20<sup>th</sup> the full Board approved, the requested conditional use and the redesign of the outdoor seating area as presented at the MNA Board meeting with the following stipulations:

- that the redesign of the existing outdoor seating area to be more in line with the historic character of the building, as suggested by City staff.

- that the patio would close by 10pm.

## ATTACHMENT #1: SUPPLIMENTAL REGULATIONS FOR OUTDOOR EATING AREAS ASSOCIATED WITH FOOD AND BEVERAGE ESTABLISHMENTS. (MGO §28.151)

## Outdoor Eating Areas Associated with Food and Beverage Establishments.

- (a) Primary access to the area shall be from within the establishment.
- (b) Hours of operation may be restricted and noise and lighting limits imposed as part of the conditional use approval.
- (c) Where the use is conditional, an appropriate transition area between the use and adjacent property may be required, using landscaping, screening, and other site improvements consistent with the character of the neighborhood.
