Subparagraph d. entitled "Banks And Financial Institutions; Medical, Dental And Optical Clinics; Offices, Business And Professional; Offices Of Health, Medical And Welfare Institutions; Radio And Television Studios And Stations; Retail Stores And Retail Service Uses" of Paragraph 5. entitled "Commercial and Manufacturing Uses" of Subdivision (I) entitled "Schedule Of Required Off-Street Parking Facilities" of Subsection (3) of Section 28.11 entitled "Off Street Parking and Loading Facilities" of the Madison General Ordinances is amended to read as follows:

"d Banks and financial institutions; medical, dental and optical clinics; offices, business and professional; offices of health, medical and welfare institutions; radio and television studios and stations; retail stores and retail service uses. One parking space shall be provided for each three hundred (300) one thousand (1,000) square feet of gross floor area."
