Included in this submittal are plans and sign details for the Breese Stevens Entrance Improvements located at 917 E. Mifflin Street and 902 E. Washington Avenue.

The Breese Stevens entrance improvements involve renovation of the two corners located on E. Mifflin St. and N Patterson St.; and E Washington Ave. and N Patterson St. to promote these areas as public plazas and entranceways to Breese Stevens Field.

The first phase of this project will include removing and replacing the existing deteriorating concrete, installation of benches, bollards, tables, trees, waste receptacles and monument signage.

Project construction is anticipated to begin mid July and to be completed September 9, 2011 to coincide with the break between soccer seasons.

Below are the details regarding colors and materials for the entrance improvements at Breese Stevens.

Metal Site Furnishings depending on purchasing requirements, we will either purchase the below exact products, or an equivalent. I have attached the product information for the site furnishings to this e-mail.

- Seating: Sitescapes Cityview Seating 6' length, backed, cast iron ends, no center arm rests, powder coat black
- Tables: Sitescapes Cityview Table 48" round, 4-seat and 3-seat option, backed seats, surface mount, powder coat black
- Trash Receptacles: Sitescapes City View Trash Receptacle, 36 gallon, top opening, surface mount, flat top, powder coat black
- Bollards: Wausau Tile TF6127 black stain (not shown on .pdf but commercially available)

Concrete - Standard Gray

Star Emblem within Concrete Plaza - will match color of existing stone façade. This will be an integral concrete mix. Color samples are required to be submitted to the project manager for both the standard color and the proposed star emblem to compare. The exact determination will be made at the time of product submittal. I am anticipating that the color of the emblem will match a color similar to Brickform's Liquid Integral Color LC-2245 Limestone available at http://www.brickform.com/images/color_cards/LiquidIntegral_ColorChart-1-large.jpg.

Sign Option A: Stone facia to match existing stone facia at Breese Stevens, concrete will be standard color.


Sign Option B: Stone facia to match existing stone facia at Breese Stevens, sign panel will be an aluminum panel painted to match existing dark brown doors on building, with accent red/orange banding to match existing tile on building, star emblem on each column to match painted brown aluminum, or to be constructed out of bronze with dark brown patina.






