Erdman reviewed the Executive Director's report which also covered Item 6b on the Agenda:

Revival Ridge

- Erdman provided an update on security and public safety in the neighborhood.
- Have allowed a kiosk to be placed on the Revival Ridge property.

- Application for Affordable Housing Trust Fund to establish a construction loan fund has been submitted.
- Working on the selection of a marketing company to assist with a logo, web page and print materials.
- Two neighborhood residents have been selected to test the Home Buyer Education and Readiness Screening Process.

6 25012 MOSAIC RIDGE UPDATE & DISCUSSION

6a Review of Plans & Affordability

Erdman reviewed the estimated home pricing, elevations and floor plans prepared by Kegonsa Builders for two-bedroom single-story, three-bedroom two-story and four-bedroom two-story units.

- Units will be Wisconsin Green built and Focus on Energy certified, high energy efficient and well insulated.
- Need another 10,000 to 15,000 to hit the number we need for very low-income households.
- We are in good shape on the 80% of median income group.
- Three- and four-bedroom units cost about the same. We are off about a hundred dollars per month in serving a family of four to five persons at 50% of median income.
- Kegonsa Builders produced a work sheet describing:
 - o CDA encouraged specs not included in estimate.
 - o CDA specs included in estimate.
 - Kegonsa recommended options.
 - Sales tax exempt and living wage yet to be factored in.
