Dear Resident / Business Owner / Owner,

The City of Madison Board of Public Works will hold a public hearing on the issue of allowing construction activities, with associated noise impacts, outside the time of 7:00 AM to 7:00 PM for asphalt paving on Gammon Rd from Schroeder Rd to Seybold Rd. The Public Hearing will be on Wednesday April 6th, 2011 at 5:30 PM at the City County Building, 210 Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd, Room 108A.

Madison General Ordinance section 24.08(3) provides the Common Council the ability to allow construction activities outside of the hours of 7:00 AM to 7:00 PM. with the passage of a resolution and a public hearing before the Board of Public Works.

Gammon Road from Schroeder Rd to Seybold Rd is scheduled for curb & gutter replacement, pavement milling and asphalt resurfacing in May of 2011. The first phase includes replacing deteriorated sections of curb and gutter. The second phase includes milling the existing pavement. The third phase includes placing the final surface of asphalt pavement.

Phases one and two will be completed between the hours of 7:00 AM and 7:00 PM. Phases one and two can be performed around normal traffic volumes without adversely affecting the quality of the construction and without a big impact on traffic. The contractor is required to maintain access to all businesses at all times. This work will last approximately 2 to 3 weeks.

Phase three will be completed between the hours of 9:00 PM and 6 AM because: Traffic turning in and out of the businesses on Gammon Rd and Watts Rd in phase 3 could adversely affect the newly placed surface. Performing this work during reduced traffic volumes will produce a better product and provide the least interruption to the businesses. This work will take place in one or two nights in late May.
