DRAFTER’S ANALYSIS: This ordinance will eliminate the rule against using generators at food cart vending sites in the 700 and 800 blocks of the State Street Mall.

The Common Council of the City of Madison do hereby ordain as follows:

Subparagraph b. of Paragraph 2. entitled “Use of Electricity” of Subdivision (l) entitled “Miscellaneous Vending Restrictions” of Subsection (6) entitled “Regulations and Procedures for Vending on the State Street Mall/Capitol Concourse” of Section 9.13 entitled “License for Selling on Public Streets” of the Madison General Ordinances is hereby repealed.

EDITOR’S NOTE: Section 9.13(6)(l)2.b. of the Madison General Ordinances currently reads as follows:

“b. The use of generators to run equipment at vending sites located in the 700 and 800 blocks of the State Street Mall is strictly prohibited.”
