









The old Germania House, 510 E. Wilson St., hotel, boarding house and saloon of the Gay Nineties, is shown above. The two-story brick structure, with family living quarters and rooms for boarding, was a favorite stopping-off place

for musicians when it was operated from 1879 to 1913 by John Sachs, local band leader and violin player. Sachs, with mustache and derby, stands in front of the entrance centered among a group of men, on the old wooden sidewalk.


