Community Development Division is applying for three positions, a lead worker in CDBG (federally funded position), Energy Block Grant position (tied to stimulus money), and Neighborhood Liaison (City tax levy). No word yet on if the positions will go through or not. There is an AASPIRE intern working in OCS, Jocelyn Gibert. The management of neighborhood centers is moving to OCS and will be under Laura Noel and Lorri Wendorf's management. It was formerly done in both CDBG and OCS. Central Guadalupe closed on Friday with only a couple days notice. People quickly came together and the Madison Catholic Parishes have gotten the ok to jointly run the center. We will keep this item on the agenda for further updates. 7.
