Dear Ald. Zellers,

I live a block from Hotel Red, on Madison St. Hotel Red have been good neighbors. But I am against their plan to expand. The original plan there was for a 7-story building. But that was rejected because it didn't fit into the neighborhood. So the Hotel is 4 stories tall. The proposed addition of 2 1/2 floors is also too tall. And especially with the new 4-story building going up on the corner of Oakland and Monroe, the extra traffic would be dangerous for children walking to Randall, to the bus to Franklin and to West High. Plus the proposed restaurant on top, with outdoor seating, would allow noise. We already get enough noise from football games. Those are only a few days/year. But the restaurant would be every day. And nothing would block the noise because of the height of the building. And also allowing this exception to the neighborhood height rules would allow future building to violate the rules.

Please vote against this proposal.
