I just received an email (attached) from Julia Matthews, District 12 alder, with important new information regarding this legislation. Staff has advised that "name changes mid street are really only allowed at a crossing or an at least 90 degree bend in the road." I bring this to your attention because this standard does not appear anywhere in the staff materials for Legistar 90545. This permits the use of the Ruskin Street name to its intersection with Coolidge Street, which resolves the issues presented by this legislation. However, this does not address the equity issue; should you decide to rename Ruskin Street, the Ruskin Street businesses receive no reimbursement in the current legislation. That's not fair or equitable and must be remedied.
