#### Title

CAPITAL BUDGET AMENDMENT # 8 - Parks / New Project - James Madison Park Improvements, p. 90

#### Body

This project provides funding for improvements at James Madison Park and other parklands. A detailed master plan will be developed for the park, and may eventually include many of the following components: grading and restoration of house sites; garden, terrace and accessible paths; parking, lighting, and public art; lakeshore pier; lakeshore staircase and gazebo; playground and shelter furnishings; irrigation, signage, bocce, horseshoe, and exercise areas; and major shelter renovation for restaurant-concession. Project costs are to be entirely offset

by proceeds from long-term lease revenues at the park. Improvements will not be made until lease revenues are received. Proceeds will be divided equally between James Madison Park and general parklands.
