REPORT: Fuel Procurement

At the request of the Board of Estimates the following report has the recent fuel purchasing history along with some history for the Division.

Prior to the fuel "crisis" of the late 1970's and early 80's the Division purchased fuel on the "spot market". What this meant was that when fuel was needed the Division would contact vendors for their current price, accept the low bid and place the order. As fuel became increasingly difficult for vendors to guarantee delivery, the Division began to put annual requirements out for competitive bid. This was done to ensure delivery, and secondary to that was a fixed price. This process of going out for annual bid continued through the mid 1980's. In the mid 80's and early 90's fuel was again purchased using the spot market approach as fuel was more readily available and pricing using this structure was more favorable. As fuel pricing and availability again became and issue during the mid 90's to date, the Division has tended to put fuel out for an annual bid process.

The most recent bidding process has yielded the following:

A bid was prepared and solicited in December of 2005 for the Division needs for the first half of 2006. This six-month term was chosen to coincide with the expiration of a bid that Madison Metro had entered into. The thought was that combining the needs of both could result in a lower cost during the second half of 2006. When the bids were received in December of 2005 the cost per gallon of fuel was over the 2006 budget. It was determined that it would not be prudent to enter into a contract that was over budget. At that point the decision was made to use the State of Wisconsin cooperative purchasing agreement for the Divisions needs. We are currently using this agreement for our fuel requirements. The pricing structure that is utilized for this is essentially a spot market pricing based on a published standard.

Recently bids were solicited for both Metro and Fleet Service. One bid was received on 8/24/06 (attachment #1) and the second bid was received on 9/6/06 (attachment #2). The first of these bids was rejected due to confusion with the product that the vendors were supplying. The products that were bid for Fleet Service needs were consistent between both bids received. Of particular note the price of unleaded fuel dropped \$0.1401 per gallon, and diesel dropped \$0.0744 per gallon during this two-week period. Both of these bids yielded results that were over the Fleet Service budget for fuel. The decision was made to re-bid the fuel requirements for the Division later in the year.

Currently the Fleet Service Division as of the most recent deliveries is paying \$2.17 per gallon for Ultra-low sulfur diesel (9/18/06) and \$2.16 per gallon for unleaded gasoline.

Attached are graphs that show recent trends in crude oil prices and gasoline prices. Please note that these prices are at a retail level. (attachment #3)

A chart is also attached showing the bid price of December 2005 versus the actual price paid by the Division for the 6-month contract period beginning January 2006. (attachment #4)

Attachment #5 shows historical market data for diesel fuel from 1994 through August 2006.

Attachment #6 contains data from fuel billing to agencies showing comparison information from 2005 versus 2006, both in cost and quantity.

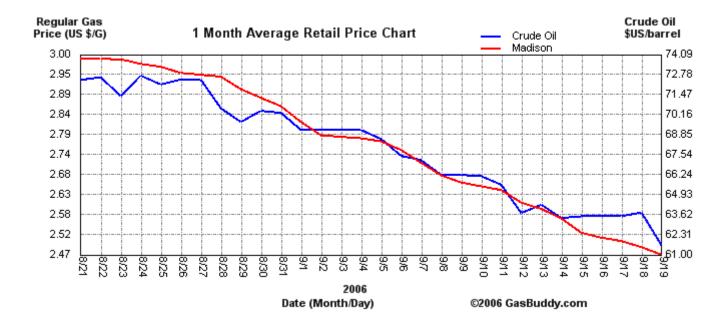

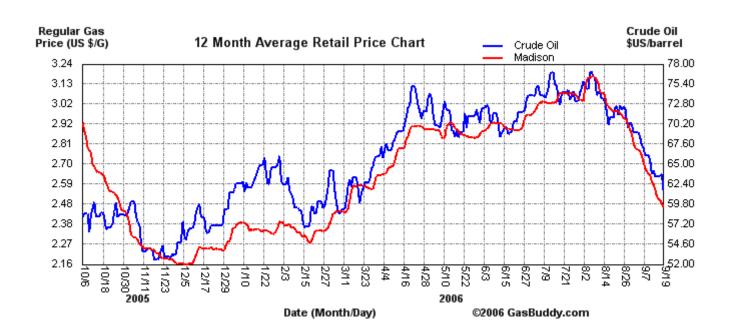
