- 6- Madison Water Utility's service charge has been adjusted to remove public fire protection for comparison purposes. With the 2018 rate order, public fire protection is no longer a separate direct charge to customers but is included in the service charge. In this comparison, \$6.09 per quarter (based on the previous \$2.03 monthly fire protection charge) has been subtracted from the service charge.
