1202 Gilbert Road, built in 1941

(Staff has no historic file for this house.)

Proposal: Demolish single-family residence and construct new residence



5210 Harbor Court, built in 1925

(Staff has no historic file for this house.)

Proposal: Demolish single-family residence to create open space for adjacent residential bldg.



1440 Linden Drive: Pre-school Laboratory

Built in 1955 to replace a temporary building, the Pre-School Laboratory offers childcare for University faculty and students, as well as Madison residents.

1430 Linden Drive: Home Management House

Built in 1940 the University of Wisconsin-Madison for the Department of Home Economics (School of Human Ecology). It was called the Home Management House. Construction on the house began in 1940 and it was completed in June 1941 at a cost of \$33,900. The house is roughly 57 feet wide by 31 feet deep.

Students and faculty once used the house as a home economics practice house, where up to eight students lived for two weeks at a time during their senior year. This period enhanced classroom education and provided hands-on learning in the areas of budgeting and time and household management.

In the mid-1960s the home was converted for office use..
