


BACKGROUND

- Rate changes have typically been implemented every three years to address revenue needs to support the system and future improvements/new facilities, balance system demand, and encourage other modes of transportation.
- Rate changes have historically been on a three-year rotation.
- ☐ The last rate change was in 2018.
- On-street meter rates are priced higher than off-street parking rates
- Periodic rate increases help develop reserves for replacement of garages and other capital projects.

Average Peak Occupancy




AVERAGE PEAK GARAGE OCCUPANCY RATES 2020 - 2023

24/7 MONTHLY PARKING RATES

- State St Campus and Wilson Garage have highest nearby competition
- Lake St Garage closure will eliminate 529 spaces
- No monthly rate changes at Cap Square North, South Livingston, or Wilson Garage
- Anticipate increased demand at State St. Campus, Overture, and State St. Capitol with Lake Garage closure.

SPECIAL EVENT PARKING RATES

- Current rate set at \$8 maximum, regardless of the event size or impact on a facility.
- Nearby event rates range from \$15 \$40.
- Event parking demand is highest at State St. Campus, State St. Capitol, and South Livingston Garages.
- Below market rates discourage using other transportation options.
- Special Event or Pay on Entry (POE) would begin two (2) hours prior to the start of the event and are valid until 7a the next morning.

Tiered System	Price	Attendees	Triggers
Level 1	\$10.00	1,200 – 2,999	 lower impact special events that trigger POE downtown area community events (Night Market, Concerts on the Square, etc.) not venue specific.
Level 2	\$15.00	3,000 – 9,999	 sell-out or near sell-out events, or multiple events occurring at nearby venues. South Livingston Street and State Street Campus Garage, this tier would apply to events with under 10,000 expected attendees, such as concerts and other events.
Level 3	\$20.00	10,000 +	apply primarily to State Street Campus Garage or South Livingston Garage during highly attended Kohl Center, Camp Randall, or nearby venue events.
