## **Summary**

For the building at 2604 Waunona Way, Bailey said that staff recommended a finding of historic value related to Madison's vernacular architecture, but the building itself is not historically significant; and the site has historic value as a human burial site significant to the Ho-Chunk Nation, which will need to secure a Request to Disturb before any ground-disturbing work.

Bailey said that staff recommended a finding of no known historic value for the buildings at 6105 S Highlands Avenue and 2326 Vondron Road.
