An investigation indicated the suspect, who was charged w/ DC while armed, was in the Anchor Inn w/ his girlfriend when another bar patron got into an argument over the suspects girlfriend. The argument spilled into the parking lot and became a fight w/ the suspect obtaining the bat from the trunk of his car. The 2d participant in the fight was not located. Officers gave suspect a ride home as he was too intoxicated to drive.

The problem patron was contacted, admitted to having been unruly in the past, however, denied the "gasoline" statement. Officers served an Unruly Patron form on the patron with an explanation.

Incident The suspect in this incident had punched the bar owner while being escorted out of the bar, continued to resist until Police arrived and resisted the Police by threatening to kill them, kill their families, resisting attempts to handcuff him, resisting attempts to place him in the squad car and spitting on the Officers. Subject was very verbally abusive, threatening and persistently resistive throughout his entire contact with Officers. He was described as 6ft and 200lbs, making it difficult for the two arresting Officers to place him in the squad car when he resisted. At one point while being restrained in the squad, the suspect attempted to kick the Officer in the face. Due to the fact the suspect was vomiting on himself and in the squad car, he was conveyed to Detox. He was charged with Battery, resisting and was issued an unruly patron form as requested by the bar owner.

Incident The immensity of this disturbance / melee can only be appreciated by quotes and excerpts from reports filed by officers: 1: " he identified himself as a bartender for the Majestic Nightclub. He indicated there was a fight in progress inside of the bar that the bouncers could not break up. As I entered the bar, I noted on the southwest side of the nightclub a fight taking place. There were a large number of individuals involved in this fight. I also noted the bouncers were actively attempting to separate the combatants. As I approached the fight, I noted members in the crowd, both males and females, were arming themselves with bottles. I observed individuals attempting as well as being successful in breaking bottles over the heads of other combatants. The fight was completely out of control and the best I could do was get in the middle of the immediate combatants and attempt to separate them. " Once outside, the number of people involved in the fight grew. " 2: "It should be noted that there were hundreds of people in the middle of the street and that the general scene was one of chaos ... even given the additional resources of the robbery personnel along with patrol there was not enough people there to successfully make arrests of all involved parties" 3: I would like to emphasize the lack of cooperation by those parties involved in the fight. So much that I was concerned for my safety as well as the safety of the officers responding to the scene. We were grossly outnumbered by what I would deem a very hostile crowd." 4: "The disturbance was so large we did not have the resources to make the necessary arrest of the agitators to stop the disturbance in a quicker manner." 5: " Several other fights were breaking out along Doty Street near the ramp next to the Great Dane Pub" 6: I got bumped back into the building by the crowd continuously getting pushed and was not able to grab on to . I would have had to go through approximately 10 to 12 people at this time. " 6: "If Officer Heimsness had not been there I believe that (arrested subject) would have grabbed me from behind when I wasn't looking. I wasn't able to get his name and find out more about the blood and how it got there". 7: "When some of the people in the group saw officers approach them they dispersed".

Incident A security person from this establishment called Police regarding a subject, who was part of a group, causing a disturbance while being checked at the door and was refused entrance. This subject then refused to leave and Police were called. While talking to security personnel, the suspect and others in the group began yelling at the security person and Officers and creating another disturbance on the sidewalk. Officers described some of the subjects involved as intoxicated or very intoxicated and at least two were underage. When the group continued to be disruptive rather than leave, Officers started arresting people after a melee broke out. Eventually four suspects were arrested for a total three counts of Disorderly Conduct, two counts of resisting and one count of obstructing. Not including Shorewood PD assistance, Madison Police spent 8 hrs and 38 min total to handle this disturbance. (This time would not include any follow-up by Dets, court Officers etc.) This event was very similar to some that have occurred on King St.
