NEW BUSINESS ITEMS

1. 30 Dixon Street - Tina Murray appealing MGO 32.04(4)(a). An extension by the Building Code, Fire Code and Licensing Appeals Board is required for rent abatement purposes. The original Official Notice did not allow enough time to complete the work required. The variance items relate to the stairway that was approved on precedence.

2. 1015 E. Washington Avenue - Diana Dorschner of Dorschner Associates, Inc. appealing IBC 10033.3.1. Handrails. The variance requested is to waive the handrails required in this two step condition at the door. The owner is creating a water barrier to prevent water flooding into the building.
