Re: Alcohol License for Cafe Coda

Dear ALRC members:

At the board meeting of December 12th the Marquette Neighborhood Association Board (MNA) passed a motion related to the application for a liquor license:

MNA supports the application for Cafe Coda to the ALRC and the Plan Commission for a nightclub venue with the following conditions:

- 1) a maximum of two dance events per week with a maximum of one event held on Friday or Saturday night.
- 2) the club will close by midnight.
- 3) the decibel level in adjacent residences (apartments) will not exceed 60 decibels.
- 4) there will be a maximum capacity of 99 people.
- 5) the club will continue to maintain a strong community engagement program in cultural arts and creative music, e.g. world music review, documentaries.

It was the Board's understanding that the applicant agreed to these conditions during the meeting of December 12th. Thank you for considering this when deliberating on the alcohol license application.
