


Successful multifamily housing transactions using LIHTC



- Baker Tilly's Don Bernards has had a standing seat on WHEDA tax credit advisory committee for approximately 15 years
- From 2021 through 2023, Baker Tilly clients were awarded WHEDA LIHTC credits for projects totaling 1,480 total units including projects in Madison.

Last year alone, Baker Tilly submitted 25% of WHEDA LIHTC applications.

- In the last 3 years, Baker Tilly worked on **five** non-competitive 4% projects.
- In 2023, projects on which Baker Tilly consulted represented 49.6% of the units receiving awards under the state 4% round
- Baker Tilly is currently working with a housing authority in the southeast on two housing projects utilizing essential function bonds totaling \$37 million
- Baker Tilly works with many of the Inflation Reduction Act energy efficiency, climate resiliency and decarbonization credits and incentives.






