RESOLUTIONS APPROVING THE CONSTRUCTION OF PUBLIC WORKS PROJECTS

Estimated cost of this project is \$75,348. The contract proposes the installation of 278 trees and 1,533 native plants. The majority of the trees are replacements for trees that have died due to age or have had to be removed after being struck by vehicles. In some medians, ornamental trees are being planted for the first time. We are continuing to experiment with native grasses and prairie plants in medians. We have enjoyed a positive response from the public in this effort. (The tulips and daffodils are not prairie plants but provide some color in the spring before the prairie plants.)

The limits of the proposed tree project are as follows:

Old Sauk Rd. from W. Beltline Hwy. to Pleasant View Rd. Old Sauk Rd. from W. Beltline Hwy. to N. High Point Rd. Riva Rd. Cameron Rd. from Raymond Rd. to Prairie Rd. Raymond Rd. from Reetz Rd. to Canterbury Rd. Whitney Way from Hammersley Rd. to Raymond Rd. Portland Parkway from Belmont Rd. to Diamond Dr. Acewood Blvd. from Bob-o-link to Meredith Ave. Acewood Blvd. from Cottage Grove Rd. to Leo Dr. Cottage Grove Rd. from Eldon Ct. west to Hwy. 51 Eau Claire Ave. from Regent St. to Old Middleton Rd. Anderson St. from Hwy. 51 to Wright St. Kinsman Blvd. from Hwy. 51 to Hoffman St. Bonner Lane from Cody Lane to Havey Rd.
