

BPW Meeting April 17, 2013:

Review of Projects by Engineering Environmental Staff for Impacts to Water Resources

20. Jeffy Trail Bike Path, etc.

This project, which also involves installing a sanitary sewer main, will require a Notice of Intent permit for disturbing over an acre, a wetland individual permit (for disturbing ~670 sf of wetland), a clear span bridge general permit, a utility crossing general permit, a Dane County erosion control permit for disturbing over 4,000 sf, and a City of Madison erosion control permit. **(Anthony Fernandez, City Engineering)**

21. Warner Bike Paths and Bridge Replacement

This project will disturb over an acre (requires Notice of Intent), replace two bike bridges (requires 2 Individual Chapter 30 Permits), and clip the edge of a wetland (requires a Wetland Individual Permit). A City of Madison Erosion Control Permit is also required. **(Anthony Fernandez, City Engineering)**
