1. The entertainment offered in the courtyard will be ambiance-driven live music (genres to be pulled from will be classical, jazz, international, traditional, bluegrass, etc.) and will be music that wouldn't require amplification, though they will be plugged into the system so that the three restaurants can have the courtyard music playing in their respective establishments, should they choose to channel it in. Additional DJ sets will be scattered throughout the schedule, but will be limited to creating a more chill vibe in the courtyard for all to enjoy. There are currently no security personnel hired for the operation of the courtyard and there are no plans to hire any additional security personnel with the addition of live entertainment. The goal is to replace the current musical offerings via Pandora, Spotify and personal play lists while offering another venue to showcase Madison's local musical talent that falls within the specified range of genres.
2. There is no parking lot associated with Robinia Courtyard and we control no on premise parking. We have zero anticipation of booking any music that would generate an entrance line to any shows ever. Should one be created for some unforeseen wild musical show, there is ample space within the tunnel for a line to form without interfering with any property not controlled by Robinia Courtyard. There are two entrances to the courtyard. The gated tunnel and the main entrance at 829 E. Washington Avenue. All patrons are instructed, through signage and/or interaction with the employees of A-OK where to go for service at the desired locale (Barolo, A-OK or Julep) Outdoor seating will be segregated via outdoor café dividers similar to what you would find on any curbside outdoor seating scenario. All patrons are sat AFTER interacting with the appropriate establishment host or bartender during dinner hours. After dinner hours are completed for Julep (10pm on weekdays, 11pm on weekends) an employee will be placed at the gate for the courtyard and they will be responsible for carding anyone approaching from the gate. All servers/bartenders will be responsible for checking ID at the point of sale as well. After dinner there will be no one allowed under 21 on the premises, as a rule. With respect to litter and noise, staff will periodically walk the front of the property to ensure there is no litter accumulating within the immediate vicinity. Unruly patrons will be asked to leave and offered a complimentary cab ride home should it be deemed appropriate.
