Hello, Collin.

Here's a modified map to show you where the shoreline is accessible for people to reach the water.



These shorelines are good regardless of the water level; this past year, we had record water levels all along the watershed, and the access to the Lotus Fetch turned into an impassable bog. Lotus plants also make the fetch totally unsuitable for floating lanterns--it'll be filled in with lotus leaves and flowers. Beautiful stuff, but not easy to wade through.
