Buildings Proposed for Demolition:

1384 Williamson Street



The Applicant's Comments:

Ace Hardware Center seeks to remove a house adjacent to its present location in an effort to enhance and maintain its business. Current zoning is C2 HIS-TL. The created open space would be used for outdoor seasonal sales and storage.

Staff Comments:

1384 Williamson Street is in the Third Lake Ridge Historic District. As such, the demolition application will require a public hearing and approval by the Landmarks Commission in addition to demolition approval by the Plan Commission. According to the assessors' data base, the house was first constructed in 1894.

According to the Applicant, the hardware store will be seeking to create an outdoor sales and storage area. In 1995, during a previous consideration of an addition to the store, Ms. Kitty Rankin wrote: "This small vernacular house is a simple late 19th century building of no particular architectural or historical significance. My guess is that the Landmarks Commission and the neighborhood would not oppose demolition provided that the addition to the hardware store is designed well..."
