

PUBLIC NOTICE

AT&T will be extending its fiber optic network within the City of Madison during the months of April through October 2009. This work is being done in order to enhance existing facilities in the Madison Area.

There will be a public hearing, before the City of Madison Board of Public Works, on Wednesday, July 8, 2009 at 5:30 p.m. in Room 108 of the City-County Building, 210 Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd., Madison, WI.

Cable installation contractors hired by AT&T will install buried fiber optic cable within the roadway limits at the following location:

- Beginning in existing AT&T handhole at the intersection of Oneill Av and Aberg Av. heading east for 268' under the sidewalk along Aberg Av. crossing Aberg Av at Huxley St heading north on the west side under the sidewalk for 892' crossing Huxley St 125' north of the Kropf Av intersection from the west to the east and ending in the terrace at 1509 Huxley.
- Beginning at the intersection of Packers Av and Melrose St, west side in terrace going west along Melrose St under the sidewalk for 2,050' to the intersection of Melrose St and Huxley St turn north on Huxley St for 150'.

The fiber cable will be directional bored and placed in the public ROW.

Restoration of any damage within the limits of the road right-of-way will be completed in accordance with the City of Madison's standard specifications. All damaged sidewalk slabs will be replaced with 5" lift concrete. All damage done to grass between sidewalk and curb will be restored with a four inch covering of black dirt and seed. All restoration required within the traveled portion of the roadway will also be completed in accordance with the City of Madison's standard specifications.
