2025 Actual Expenditures and Encumbrances (Through February):

- Total of Actual Expenditures and Encumbrances: ~\$1,820,000
- February 2025 Actual Expenditures (~\$313,000):
 - **1.** Facilities: ~\$290,400
 - 2.Fleet/Other: ~\$14,000
 - 3. Pipelines: ~\$9,000

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2025 Water Main Expense Depreciation:

- The total targeted spend amount in 2025 is \$5,000,000.
- Actual expenditures through February are ~\$9,000
- Estimated encumbrances plus expenditures through February are \$837,000





Project Update: Unit Well 19 Iron, Manganese, & Radium Treatment

- Project Budget: \$9,183,000
 - Current Status: Construction
 - Masonry on precast walls for treatment tank building addition
 - Backwash tank final testing and earthwork/fill around tank area
 - Coordination for replacing the onsite backup generator

Upcoming:

- Well rehabilitation and maintenance
- Interior mechanical, electrical, plumbing alterations





Project Update: Well 15 PFAS Treatment Facility

- Project Budget: \$5,943,000
 - Current Status: Construction
 - Roof has been closed; set final roofing top on concrete panels
 - Painting of walls, ceiling, new piping as it gets installed
 - Review of electrical installation routes, added controls infrastructure

Upcoming:

- Deep well equipment and borehole rehabilitation work (April)
- Equipment and piping connections (ongoing)

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Project Update: Well 12 Reconstruction

- Project Budget: \$8,00,000* (2025: \$800,000)
 - Current Status: Planning and Analysis
 - Review and upgrades / updates to electrical plans and specs
 - Recommendations and analysis of additional site storage 1.5M gallon reservoir*
 - Final modeling analysis for construction vulnerabilities and potential added site storage
 - Updated plans and specifications for Safe Drinking Water Loan application (6/30/2025)

Upcoming:

- Preparations of plans and specifications for Safe Drinking Water Loan Application (end of June)
- Final comprehensive design contract with SEH (through 2025)
