I attended all the JMP Disposal Surplus Criteria and Selection Committee meetings...as I attended those of the 2008 committee. It is disappointing that there is not a requirement that the houses stay in place as the 2008 surplus committee recommended, as the Tenney Lapham NH Association recommended, as Capitol Neighborhoods recommended, and as the Madison Trust for Historic Preservation recommended. The scoring might appear to address that but as

indicated in Brenda's blog (link above) what is being discussed for scoring the proposals would render the 20 points allocated to this pretty worthless. A Q&A about some of the issues is attached should you be interested.

Thanks for the work you do and for caring about the issues and integrity of the process. I particularly appreciated your clear concern about Madison's historic resources as embodied in the houses.
