**ONE BARREL BREWING COMPANY, LLC  
OPERATING AGREEMENT**

THIS OPERATING AGREEMENT is entered into this 9<sup>th</sup> day of December, 2011, by and between the undersigned member ("Member") and One Barrel Brewing Company, LLC, a Wisconsin limited liability company (the "Company"), for the purposes set forth below, and Donald R. Stroud III (the "Organizer"), solely for the purpose of making the acknowledgment at the end of this Operating Agreement.

WHEREAS, the Member has caused the formation of One Barrel Brewing Company, LLC, by having the Organizer file with the Department of Financial Institutions of the State of Wisconsin on December 9, 2011, Articles of Organization, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit A and the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, as provided by Chapter 183 of the Wisconsin Statutes (the "LLC Law");

WHEREAS, the Member hereby affirms his Membership in the Company, acknowledging the contribution and value thereof as reflected in the schedule attached hereto as Exhibit B, and assent to the operation of the Company under the LLC Law without amendment by an operating agreement, except as set forth herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and promises herein contained, the undersigned do hereby agree as follows:

1. Purpose of the Company. The purpose of the Company shall be to operate a brewery, tavern, and wholesaler; however, the Company may engage in any lawful business activity.
2. Initial Contribution. The Member has contributed the following pursuant to §183.0501 of the LLC Law and, in exchange therefore, shall own an equal and undivided Interest in the Company: Twenty-Five Thousand and Seven Hundred and 00/100 Dollars (\$25,700.00) as set forth in Exhibit B. The Member has not agreed to make any additional contributions to the Company. As used herein, the term "Interest" shall mean the interest of a Member in the assets and the profits of the Company and the rights of a Member to participate in the Company matters which are reserved to the Member under the LLC Law except as added to, modified, or eliminated by this Operating Agreement.
3. Registered Agent. The initial registered agent of the Company shall be Donald R. Stroud III with a registered office address at 25 W Main Street, Suite 300, Madison, WI 53703. A substitute registered agent may be appointed from time to time at the Company's discretion.
4. Distribution. After the Company has paid (1) any taxes or assessments levied against any real property owned by the Company; (2) any valid claims of creditors; and (3) any



expenses rightfully incurred in managing the Company, it shall distribute the Company's excess cash flow to the Member according to the Member's Interest in the Company.

5. Management of the Company.

5.1 Member Powers and Duties. Management of the Company shall be governed by §§183.0301(1), 183.0401(1) of the LLC Law and the provisions of this Operating Agreement. The Member shall be responsible for the management of the Company business and affairs. Except as otherwise limited in this Operating Agreement, the Member is authorized, in the Member's absolute discretion, to manage, administer, and operate the business and affairs of the Company.

5.2 Member Liability to the Company. So long as a Member shall act in good faith with respect to the conduct of the business and affairs of the Company and is not guilty of willful misconduct or breach of fiduciary duty, the Member shall not be liable or accountable to the Company, in damages or otherwise, for any error of judgment, for any mistake of fact or of law, or for any other act or thing which the Member may do or refrain from doing in connection with the business and affairs of the Company.

5.3 Indemnity. The Company does hereby indemnify and agree to hold the Member harmless from and against any and all losses, expenses, or damages suffered by the Company by reason of anything a Member may do or refrain from doing for and on behalf of the Company in furtherance of the Company's interests as provided in the LLC Law, and in case the Member shall, by reason of Member's conduct in accordance with this Operating Agreement, be made a party to any litigation commenced against the Company, then the Company shall protect and hold the Member harmless and shall pay all damages, costs, expenses, and reasonable attorneys' fees incurred or paid by the Member in connection with such litigation.

6. Amendment. No change or modification of this Operating Agreement shall be valid or binding upon any party, nor shall any term or condition of this Operating Agreement be considered waived by any party, unless such change, modification, or waiver is in writing and is signed by such party.

7. Construction. This Operating Agreement shall be interpreted and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Wisconsin.

8. Annual Reports. The Member appoints Donald R. Stroud III as agent and attorney in fact to file the Company's Annual Reports pursuant to § 183.0120 of the LLC Law. A substitute agent may be appointed from time to time to perform the duty under this section at the Company's discretion.

9. Application for Employer Identification Number. The Member appoints the Organizer or another designee the Member may choose to file electronically as a third-party

designee the Company's federal form SS-4 Application for Employer Identification Number (the "SS-4").



11. Entire Agreement. This Agreement represents the entire agreement by and between the Member and the Company. This Agreement may be amended at any time in writing by the Member.


