#### **SUMMARY:**

On February 3, 2004, the Common Council adopted Resolution No. 61179, approving the Objectives and Criteria for the Façade Improvement Grant Program. The resolution specifies that all façade proposals be referred to the Urban Design Commission for comments and recommendations.

Attached for your review is the following facade proposal:

#### **501 State Street: The Stop and Shop Grocery**

The building is an older 19<sup>th</sup> century "flatiron" structure completely updated in 1902 for Henry Lewis drug store, with apartments above. The Lewis Pharmacy was located here until around 1956.

There are two facades: State Street West Gilman Street

#### **State Street Facade**

- 1. Replace the entry doors with a more compatible design to be approved by K.H. Rankin.
- 2. Replace flashing.
- 3. Replace downspouts.
- 4. Replace warped and damaged wood boards with azek composite material. Color and form to match existing.

5. Replace fascia boards.

#### **West Gilman Street Facade**

- 1. Replace fascia boards.
- 2. Replace flashing.
- 3. Replace, patch and repair all damaged stucco to match existing.
- 4. Remove and replace balcony railing with azek composite materials.
- 5. Replace warped, rotted and damaged wood boards with azek composite material. Color and form to match existing.
- 6. Replace downspouts.
- 7. Replace the entry doors with a more compatible design to be approved by K.H. Rankin.
- 8. Repair and patch parge coat over foundation wall.

Total project cost is estimated at \$91,700 Facade grant requested is \$25,000

### **RECOMMENDATION:**

The above application has been reviewed by the Façade Improvement Grant Staff Team and meets the requirements of the Program. The Staff Team recommends approval of the above Facade Improvement Grant proposal with comments regarding the signage and light fixtures. Also, K. H. Rankin will review and approve the design for the railing at the second floor balcony over the main entrance as well as the design of the entrance doors.


