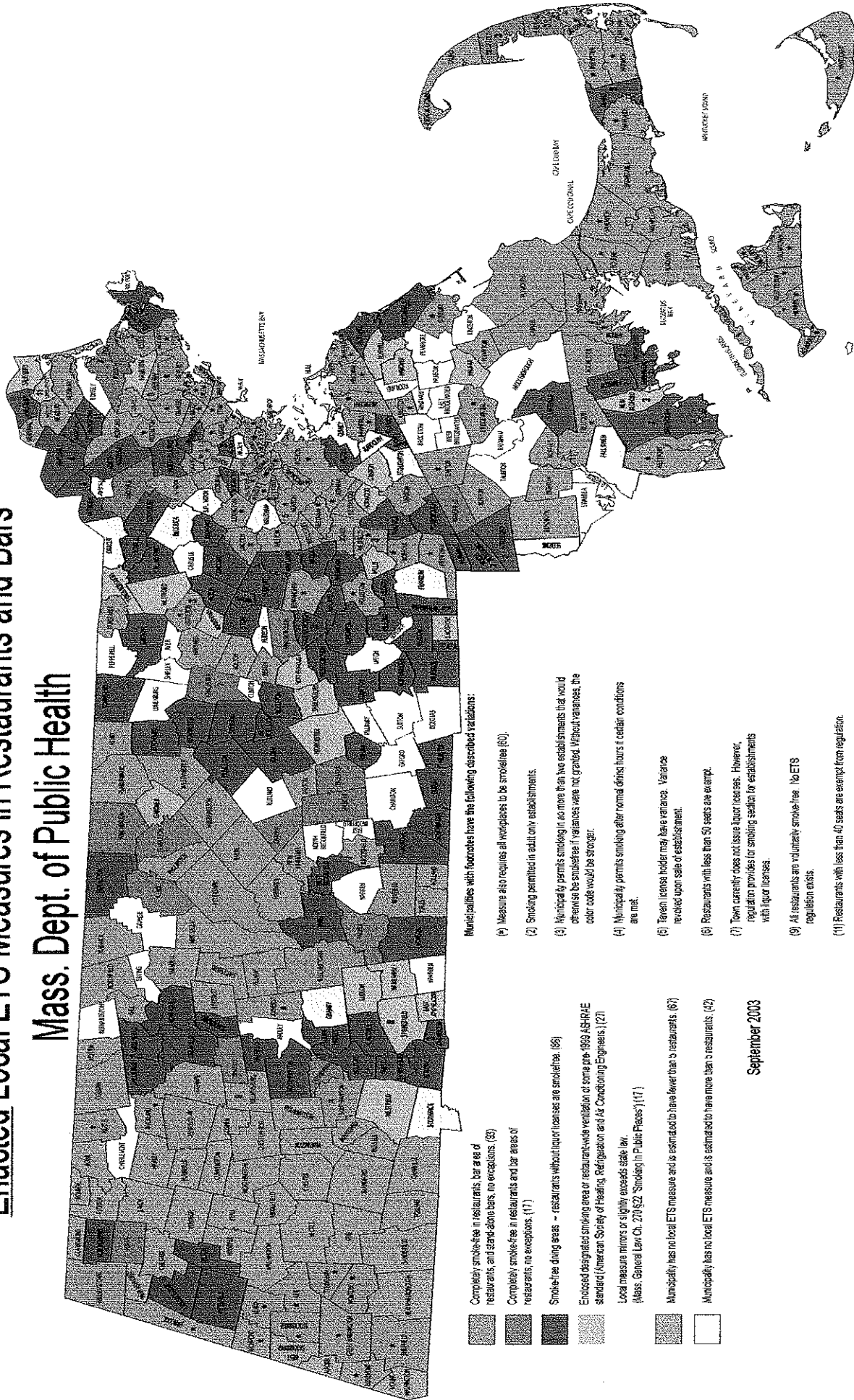


# Enacted Local ETS Measures in Restaurants and Bars

- Municipalities with footnotes have the following described variations:
- (1) Measure also requires all workplaces to be smokefree (60).
  - (2) Smoking permitted in adult-only establishments.
  - (3) Municipally permits smoking in no more than two establishments that would otherwise be smokefree if variances were not granted. Without variances, the color code would be stronger.
  - (4) Municipally permits smoking after normal dining hours if certain conditions are met.
  - (5) Tavern license holder may have variance. Variance revoked upon sale of establishment.
  - (6) Restaurants with less than 50 seats are exempt.
  - (7) Town currently does not issue liquor licenses. However, regulation provides for smoking section for establishments with liquor licenses.
  - (8) All restaurants are voluntarily smoke-free. No ETS regulation exists.
  - (11) Restaurants with less than 40 seats are exempt from regulation.

- Completely smoke-free in restaurants, bar area of restaurants, and stand-alone bars, no exceptions. (60)
- Completely smoke-free in restaurants and bar areas of restaurants, no exceptions. (17)
- Smoke-free dining areas - restaurants without liquor licenses are smoke-free. (66)
- Enclosed designated smoking area or restaurant-wide ventilation of some pre-1989 ASHRAE standard (American Society of Heating, Refrigeration and Air Conditioning Engineers) (21)
- Local measure mirrors or slightly exceeds state law.
- Municipality has no local ETS measure and is estimated to have fewer than 5 restaurants. (67)
- Municipality has no local ETS measure and is estimated to have more than 5 restaurants. (42)
