

105 E Lakeview Ave Recycling and Reuse Plan

1. Reuse Plan

Habitat for humanity restore was contacted on 3/12/2024 and there were no items they wanted to take from the existing home.

2. Appliance Recycling

The home to be demolished bare on the inside, so there are no appliances to be recycled from the house.

3. Mercury Recovery/Recycling

There are no items containing mercury in the building to be demolished. As previously stated, the home is gutted so there would not be any mercury present.

4. Concrete/Asphalt Recycling

The concrete/asphalt to be removed from the existing home will be from both the driveway and the foundation. The recycling will be done by the demolition crew at a local recycling center such as Wingra Stone.

5. Metal Recycling

We plan on diverting as much metal as possible from the landfill. These metal items will include things like metal rain gutters and downspouts, and any ductwork that may still be remaining in the home. These will likely be taken to C&D recycling at the Dane County landfill so they can be separated accordingly.

6. Lumber/Drywall/roofing materials

For this demolition project, there is no drywall in the home. It was left in a remodel stage so the only items on the inside are lumber. These lumber materials as well as the roofing materials will be put into a mixed materials dumpster and taken to the Dane County landfill for sorting at the C&D facility after demolition.

Documentation of compliance with the approved reuse and recycling plan will be submitted within 60 days of the completion of the demolition work.
