PROJECT DESCRIPTION



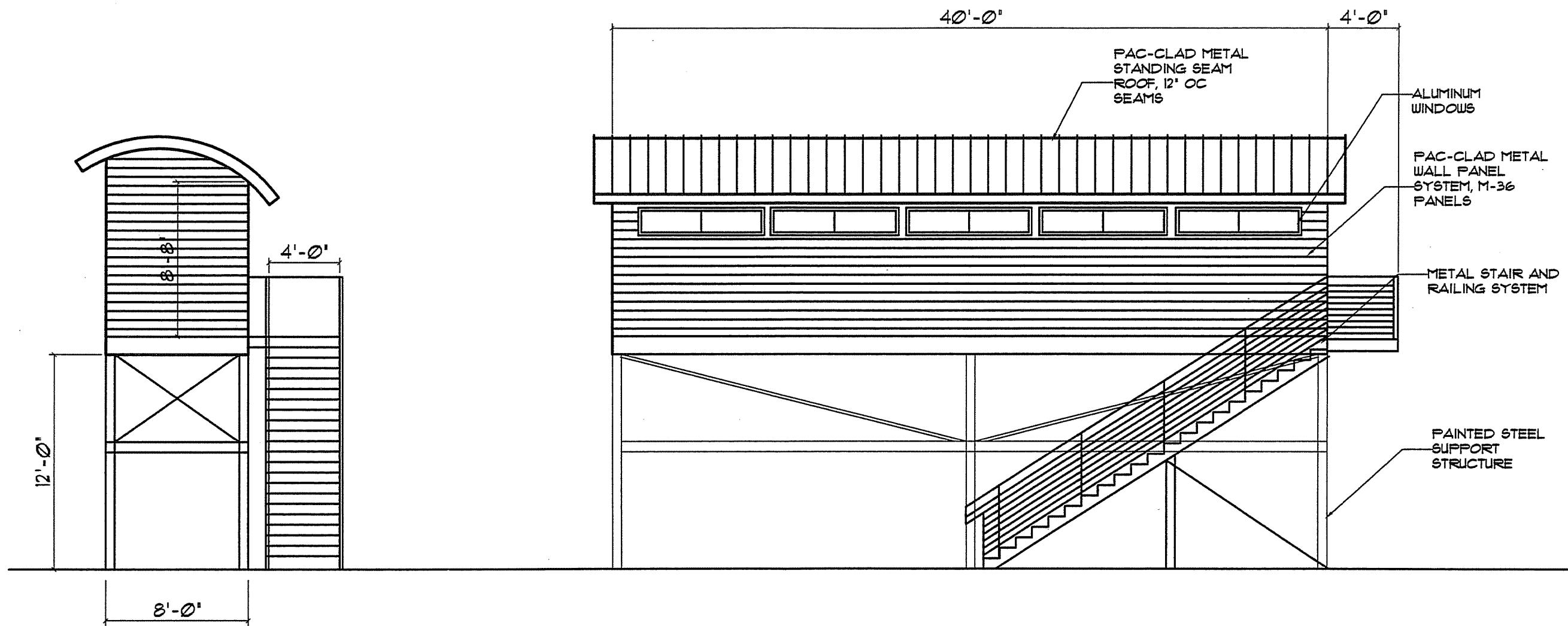

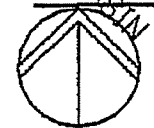
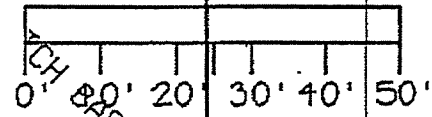
END ELEVATION

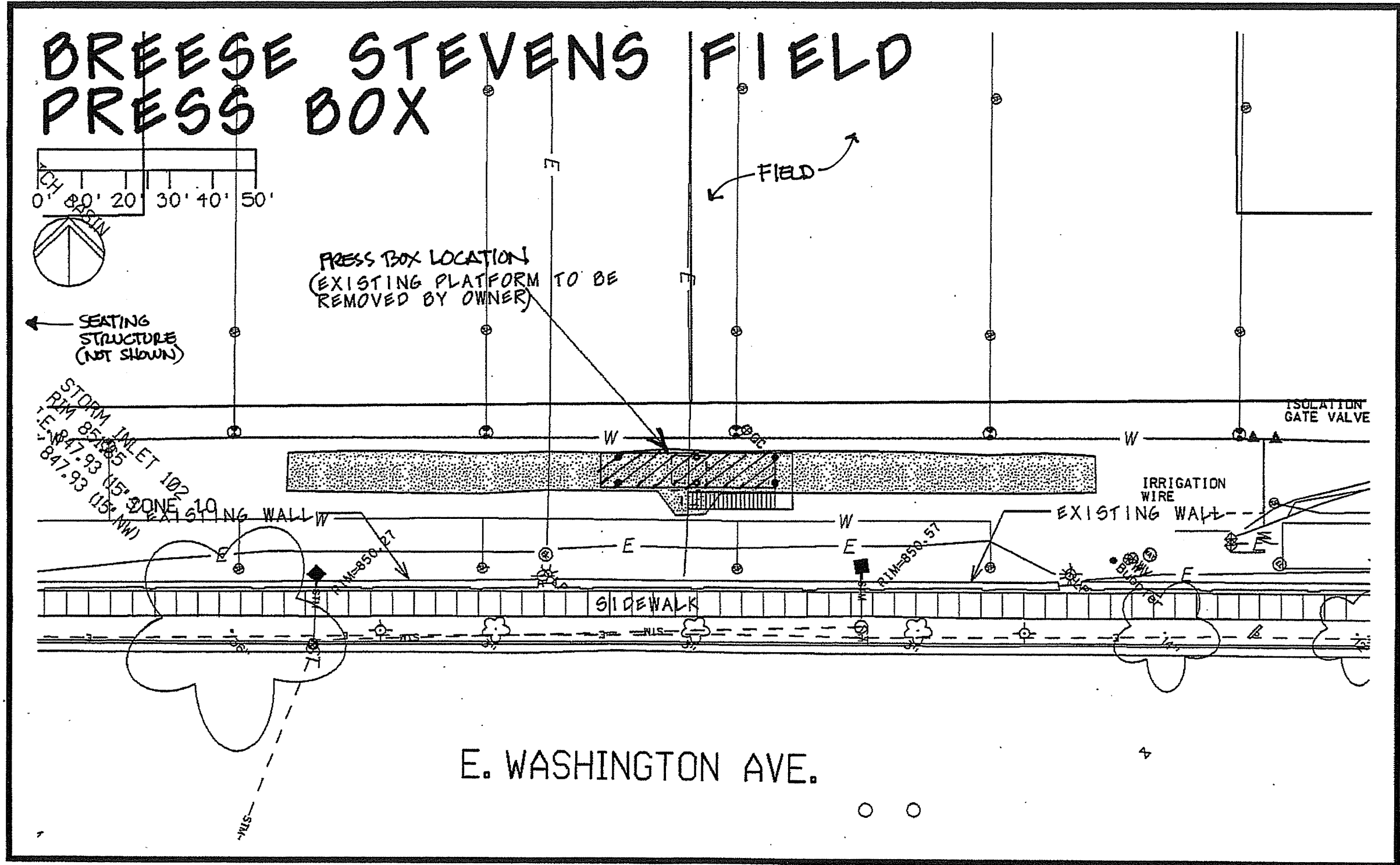
