The Committee particularly invites comments that address these concerns:

2. How can the CDBG Committee and the Community Development Division best improve their effectiveness in working with community groups to achieve the adopted goals of the Five Year Plan? Are there specific opportunities or concerns emerging in the next several years that you feel the City should be addressing through its community and neighborhood development program?

Time at a public hearing is usually short, and the Committee requests that you keep within a five-minute presentation limit. If you find the time too brief, or are unable to participate because of other reasons, the Committee would welcome your participation using other methods.
