I am writing with reference to the question you will be reviewing this evening of a fence on the property at Terrace Homes, 114-118 Breese Terrace, Madison.

I am a Terrace Homes resident. I would like to express my support for having a steel fence that is appropriate for the historical nature and the scale of our building and for our neighborhood.

I strongly feel that a fence of not greater than three (3) feet in height and with some ornamentation would enhance the appearance of the property and serve the purposes we have in mind. I believe that the manufacturer offers a three-foot fence as one of their standard heights, and that a choice of ornamentation is available.

I believe that these choices are in line with the preferences of some other Terrace Homes residents who have expressed their opinions.
