

PUBLIC NOTICE

Kentucky Data Link (KDL) will be extending its fiber optic network within the City of Madison within the next couple months, January and February, 2010. This work is being done in order to provide data delivery services in the Madison Area.

There will be a public hearing, before the City of Madison Board of Public Works, on Wednesday, January 6, 2010 at 5:30 p.m. in Room 108 of the City-County Building, 210 Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd., Madison, WI.

Cable installation contractors hired by KDL will install buried fiber optic cable within the roadway limits at the following location:

- 1. Beginning on the west side of Terrace Ct, near address 10 Terrace Ct Baker Tilly building, proceeding east along the north side of Terrace Ct for 750' to the east side of W. Terrace Drive.
- 2. Beginning at the NE corner of the intersection of W. Terrace Dr and Terrace Ct going north 250", along the east side of W. Terrace Drive to East Park Blvd.
- 3. Beginning at the SE corner of East Park & W Terrace Dr going east and north 1375' to E Terrace Dr, continuing north and east 725' to American Parkway, then east 875' to State Hwy 151 crossing.

The fiber cable will be directional bored and placed in the public ROW.

Restoration of any damage within the limits of the road right-of-way will be completed in accordance with the City of Madison's standard specifications. All damaged sidewalk slabs will be replaced with 5" lift concrete. All damage done to grass between sidewalk and curb will be restored with a four inch covering of black dirt and seed. All restoration required within the traveled portion of the roadway will also be completed in accordance with the City of Madison's standard specifications.
