Description of Premises

The Harmony Bar main level is 3,178 sq ft which includes two adjoining rooms with one bar (see floor plan provided). There is a fryer area adjacent to the bar and a full kitchen. Two bathrooms are also located on the main floor.

There are two basements totaling 3,178 sq ft. One basement (directly below the bar) is for liquor and beer storage. The other basement contains refrigeration units for proper storage of food supplies.

A seasonal patio is set up in the existing back parking area (~1,000) with table capacity for 30 people. It is separated from the rest of the lot by a tall fence to the east, 3' tall fences to the south and west, and a building to the north.
