Contract 9552 and the associated public improvements are to serve the redevelopment of 519-521 W Main Street by Vanilla 301 LLC. A certified survey map is to be completed and the new parcel will be addressed to 517 W Main Street. Public improvements required for the redevelopment include extension of public storm sewer on W Main Street and the restoration/replacement of public sidewalk, street terrace, curb and gutter, and pavement. Private work within the W Main Street right-of-way will include removal of existing drive aprons, construction of a new drive apron, and construction of private utility service laterals. No public street trees are currently anticipated for removal. Street trees may be impacted depending on the final design of the public storm sewer extension and will be reviewed with City Forestry prior to issuance of the final public improvement plans.

Contract 9553 and the associated public improvements are to serve the redevelopment of 405-407 and 431 W Gorham Street, 408-430 W Johnson Street, and 304-318 N Broom Street by Core Madison Broom, LLC. A certified survey map is to be completed and the new buildings are proposed to be addressed to 403 W Gorham Street and 423 W Johnson Street. Public street improvements required for the redevelopment include restoration/replacement of public sidewalk, street terrace, curb and gutter, and pavement on N Broom Street, W Gorham Street, and W Johson Street. Public storm utility improvements will include storm sewer structures and storm sewer extensions as needed

to provide private storm connection points to serve the redevelopment. The Developer is to provide wasterwater flows for the proposed redevelopment and if public sanitary sewer capacity upgrades are required to serve the project those improvements are to be completed by the Developer (this is TBD). Private work within public right-of-way will include removal of existing drive aprons, construction of a new drive apron on W Johnson Street, and construction of private utility service laterals. Existing public street trees are to be protected unless approved for removal by City Forestry as part of the final site plan verification approvals. New street trees are to be planted per the City Forestry approved site plans.

The Developer, 4621 LLC, has been conditionally approved for a one-lot certified map at 4621 Dutch Mill Road and 4701 Ellestad Drive. The proposed project also includes the demolition of an existing residence currently located at 4701 Ellestad Drive and the construction of a 4,425 square foot building addition for an existing concrete equipment sale and rental business, and an additional display area which the Urban Design Commission provided conditional approval on March 27, 2024. The developer shall construct public sidewalk along Dutch Mill Road and Ellestad Drive adjacent to the project frontage, maintain or replace the existing bus pad and Dutch Mill Road and Ellestad Drive, removal and replacement of curb and gutter at the abandoned driveway entrance on Ellestad Drive, connect private storm sewer pipes to a public storm structure located in the Dutch Mill Road right of way, and protect all public trees location in the public right of way. The developer will continue to use the existing sanitary lateral serving the property.

This project will CIPP line an approximately 40FR 8 inch diameter sanitary sewer main on North Mill St. This will be accomplished using thermal cure lining methods because the sewer main has a siphon (i.e. vertical pipe bends) and because there is groundwater infiltration into the pipe. Estimated City cost is \$99,250.00.
