RESOLUTIONS APPROVING THE CONSTRUCTION OF PUBLIC WORKS PROJECTS

25. <u>05814</u> Approving plans and specifications and authorizing the Board of Public Works to advertise and receive bids for Waterways 2007, Contract No. 5989. (City Wide)

This project involves various small storm sewer projects citywide to conduct necessary repairs or alleviate drainage problems. The individual projects and descriptions are listed: Dickinson St. & Spaight St. Storm Sewer: Includes adding capacity to the existing storm sewer by adding inlets and replacing existing pipes to bigger sizes. (6th AD) Estimated Subproject Cost \$65,300.00; N. Henry St. Storm Sewer Replacement: Difficult storm sewer replacement on steep slope from the end of N. Henry Street cul-de-sac to Lake Mendota. Project will increase the capacity of the present system using a terrace inlet and CDS trash containment unit. Present system overflows curb, causing erosion jeopardizing the foundation of a City Parks deck. (2nd AD) Estimated Subproject Cost \$67,500.00; Gerry Ct. Casting Replacement: Remove and replace the existing casting on the storm sewer access structure at the end of Gerry Ct. with a watertight, lockable casting to prevent back flows caused by private pump discharge when the pipe is at capacity. (8th AD) Estimated Subproject Cost \$3,000.00; Waunona Way & Hoboken Rd. Storm Sewer: Replace the existing storm sewer system in the Waunona Way & Hoboken Road intersection area with larger pipes to provide necessary capacity to drain an enclosed depression located near 1910 Waunona Way. Also replace existing tub inlets and add additional inlets to increase inlet capacity to the storm sewer system. (14th AD) Estimated Subproject Cost \$106,000.00.

26. Obo26 Approving plans and specifications and authorizing the Board of Public Works to advertise and receive bids for Local Road Traffic Calming & Arterial Pedestrian Enhancements-2007. (City Wide)

Estimated cost of this project is \$586,000. Report by City Engineering.
