Sustain Dane was identified as the principal for the City to enter into a portion that work on this project. A non-competetive sole source contract was awarded to Sustain Dane on 121 by Madison Common Council (RES-21-00519) to administer EE-NOAH. To continue this work, on 12023, another non-competitive sole source contract was awarded to Sustain Dane for \$220,500 in mmunity Development Block Grant funds and \$250,000 of American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (ARPA) Local Fiscal Recovery Funds (SLFRF) (193).
