You will shortly begin the process of selecting a new chief of police. As a downtown resident who serves on the Central District Community Policing Advisory Board, as well as a long-time board member of the downtown Capitol Neighborhoods Inc. residents' association, I would like input into that process - - both in the selection of criteria governing the selection and in the weight given the various elements of that criteria.
