**STOP Gas Station on Siggelkow and Valley/Freedom Ring Rd.**

The gas station is uncomfortably close to one of McFarland's well sites and there are concerns of water contamination due to gas storage tanks. The gas station would be between 1,100 and 1,200 feet from one of the village's main water wells. With the building of a gas station so close to residential housing, property values will also fall, directly effecting resale of family's homes. In addition an increase in traffic in the area is a safety concern for the many families directly surrounding the residential area.

\* There are many other options for this commercial space that wouldn't have water contamination concerns. It would be interesting to ask those who proposed this project if they would like to live next to a gas station.

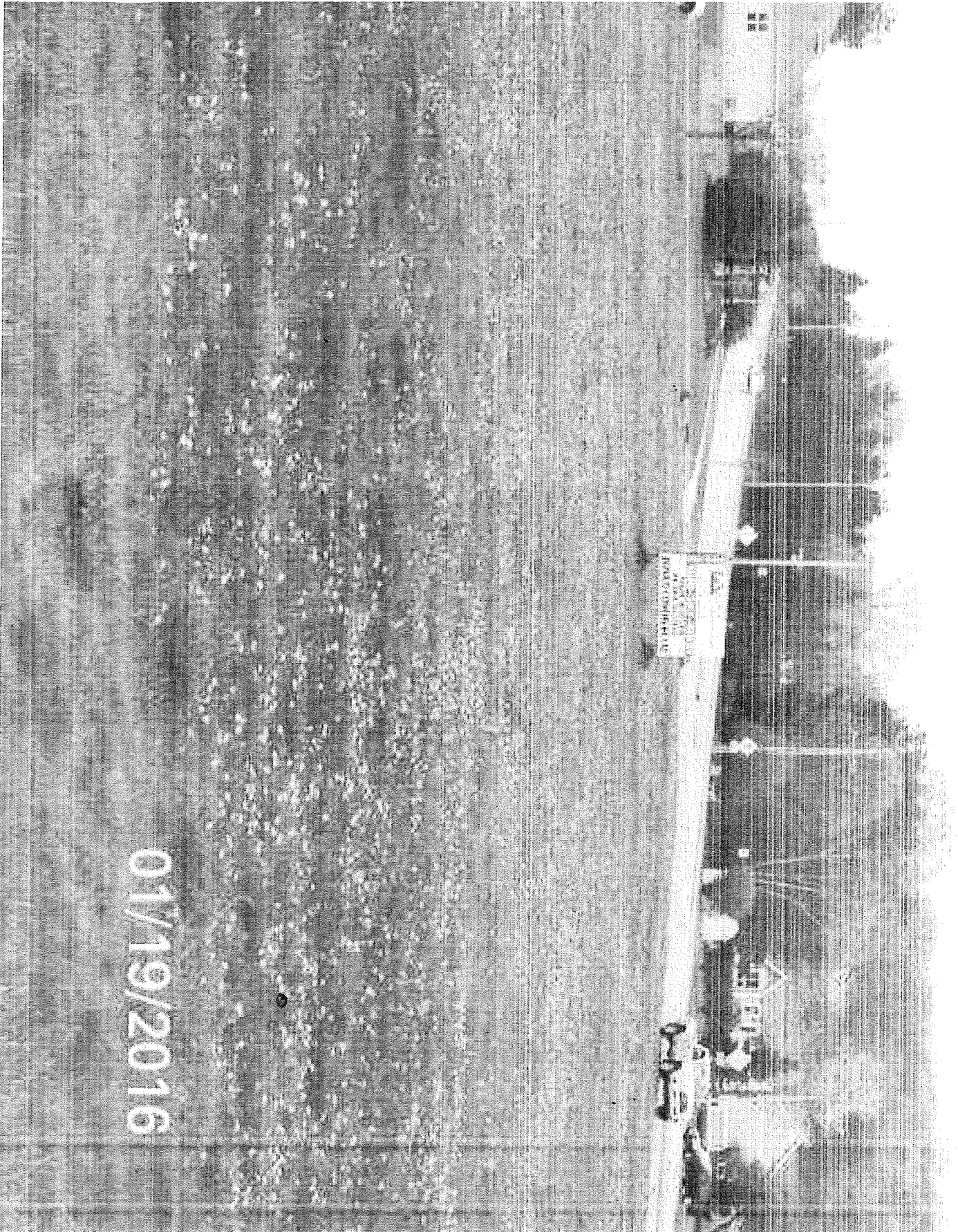
