

Public Notice

CenturyTel will be extending its fiber optic network in the City of Madison beginning in April and through May of 2009. This work will be done to complete a new fiber build to provide new service to SSM / St. Mary's Hospital in Sun Prairie, WI.

There will be a public hearing before the City of Madison Board of Public Works, on Wednesday, April 22 2009 at 5:30 p.m. in room 108 of the city county Building, 210 Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd., Madison, WI.

Contractors hired by CenturyTel will bury the new fiber optic line within the road right of way limits at the following locations:

- Beginning at the southwest corner of Anderson St and Grim St, CenturyTel will place one fiber optic cable along the south Right of Way to the east, crossing Stoughton Rd and along the south Right of Way of Lein Lien Rd to Reindahl Park.
- 2. With an easement from the Real Estate Div. and Parks Department, fiber placement will continue along the south side of Reindahl Park to E. Washington Ave (Hwy 151) and cross to the east Right of Way.
- Beginning at the south east side of E. Washington Ave (Hwy 151) at Lien Rd, fiber placement will continue north along E. Washington Ave (Hwy 151) in the east Right of Way to East Spring Dr. Fiber will continue along E. Washington Ave (Hwy 151) on the east side in the DOT Right of Way to reach the newly built St. Mary's / SSM Hospital at Reiner Rd and Hwy 151 Washington Ave (Hwy 151) in Sun Prairie, WI.

The fiber optic cable and/or will be directional bored and trenched in the public road right of way.

Restoration of any damage within the limits of the project in the right of way will restored in accordance with the City of Madison standard specifications. All damage done to terrace area will be restored with black dirt and seed.
