Hello Everyone

Because of my involvement on the CohoMadison (formerly Union Corners) cohousing project, it appears that I can no longer serve on the CDBG Committee because it violates HUD's conflict of interest guidelines. This is because 30% of our cohousing units will be affordable to persons at or below 80% of AMI, and we will be seeking subsidy funding that would ultimately need to be approved by the CDBG Committee.

So sadly, I am hereby resigning from the CDBG Committee.

I have greatly enjoyed my time on the committee. After having spend several decades on the other side of the table — working for nonprofits and coming to the committee with funding requests — I can tell you that this has been the strongest group of CDBG Committee members I can ever remember.

I won't be able to appear before you for the next twelve months, so other persons will represent the cohousing project should it come before you during the next year.

While I am sad to go, I am tremendously excited about our cohousing project, and hope to be able to announce a new location for our project within the next few weeks.
