RESOLUTION

Background: The State of Wisconsin has adopted 2011 Wisconsin Act 35 allowing for the carrying of concealed weapons. Per this new law the City of Madison has decided to post the prohibition of concealed weapons by visitors to City owned properties as provided by State law. In addition the City of Madison has issued Administrative Procedure Memorandum No. 2-46, Prohibition of Weapons, pertaining to City Employees. The Community Development Authority has after discussions among, CDA Housing Subcommittee members, including Public Housing resident representatives, and the CDA Board, determined that they will be posting the prohibition of concealed weapons on CDA owned properties.

WHEREAS, The State of Wisconsin is allowing for the carrying of concealed weapons under Wisconsin Act 35

WHEREAS, Act 35 allows residential property owners certain rights pertaining to restrictions for visitors in the carrying of concealed weapons,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the CDA will post signage on CDA operated public housing, restricting the carrying of concealed weapons to the extent authorized by law.
