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Dear Planning Committee Members,

I am writing as the president of the Greenbush Neighborhood Association, and a resident of Greenbush neighborhood, in support of ZuZu Cafe's conditional use application for 1336 Drake Street. We were surprised to hear that ZuZu needed further permission for what has become a valued event in the neighborhood, but are happy to share our view that this application should be approved. ZuZu has long been a gathering place in our community, whether for groups of children walking home for school, families having a weekend lunch, college students hosting cram sessions, or visitors from outside the neighborhood grabbing a bite when they visit the zoo.

During the pandemic they made significant effort to keep their business alive, and continue to provide a space for the community to find each other. Part of that effort was in providing safe outdoor entertainment in the evening from live music concerts. These are not wild rock shows, but instead jazz sessions with singers and a variety of instrumentation. There is minimal aural spillover into the surrounding neighborhood from the minimal amplification (Camp Randall is far louder for most residents), the shows are well attended but not mobbed, and the events wrap up by 8pm with no hub-bub from the attendees as they head home.

Our council supports ZuZu's live music events and urges the Planning Committee to allow ZuZu to keep music in the neighborhood.

I join Sue Ellingson in urging you to deny the application for amplified music at Zuzu cafe.

We live about 5 doors down from the cafe on Drake Street and we already hear the music loud and clear on Thursday evenings and Saturday evenings. We do not need it to be any louder. It is a small corner cafe with a small patio. There is no reason to amplify their sound for those gathered for the music. It will only reach people who are doing other things and trying to enjoy their own time outside in their own yard. We value the cafe as a gathering place, but we do not want to see it make the neighborhood an unpleasant place to be.

Additionally, amplified music may be disturbing and upsetting for the animals across the street at the zoo. They will certainly hear it as well. We also have various kinds of wildlife in Vilas Park and the Edgewood wooded walk nearby with frogs, cranes, hawks, owls, etc which will be disturbed as well.

If you come look at the location, you will see that there is no need for amplified sound here.

I urge you to deny the application for ZuZu Cafe to have amplified sound outside on their patio.

Amplified sound will force every resident within two blocks to listen to this music — whether they want to or not. There is no escaping amplified sound. (Imagine living *next door* to this!)

The whole patio is probably only 40' x 40'. There is absolutely no reason why acoustic music would not be sufficient for the cafe patrons sitting there.

When I was alder more than a decade ago, I dealt with many noise complaints. Amplified sound should not be permitted.
