

Vegetation Management Notice

At ATC, we know that safe and reliable electric service is important to you. An ATC forestry crew will be performing vegetation management work near the high-voltage electric lines in your area on property owned by the city of Madison. This scheduled maintenance work will begin in early 2024. This may include pruning, removing trees, the use of herbicides and the removal of hazard trees outside of the utility corridor to protect the public and power lines.

ATC is recognized by the National Arbor Day Foundation with Tree Line USA status, which demonstrates our commitment to effective tree care and management in your community. ATC forestry crews follow guidelines outlined in the American National Standard for Pruning distributed by the International Society of Arboriculture.

ATC works with the city forester and the Madison Parks Department to plan vegetation management work in utility corridors on public land, including streets, alleys, parks and greenways. ATC's vegetation management plan for your area will be considered by the Habitat Stewardship Committee during a virtual meeting on Tuesday, Nov. 7, 2023, at 4:30 p.m. with public comments at 4:45 p.m. If you have any questions about ATC's plans, register for public comment and bring them before the Habitat Stewardship Committee at that time.
