**2017 Public Health Grants and Contracts**

Public Health – Madison and Dane County (PHMDC) proposes entering into a business agreement between PHMDC and Health Care Education & Training, Inc (HCET) to support improved reproductive health access to clients at PHMDC. Specifically, these funds will allow PHMDC to become a recognized dual protection site which means that all clients will receive condoms and emergency contraception. Under the terms of the merger agreement, the Board of Health for Madison and Dane county may accept grants with the approval of the Board of Health for Madison and Dane County (IGA, VII, F, 1-3).

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Health for Madison on behalf of Public Health—Madison and Dane County authorizes the Director of Public Health, or their designee, to sign the business agreement with HCET for \$5000 in the 2017 budget.
