

# SCLS Library Board Report to Madison Public Library Board

I attended my first South Central Library Service Board of Trustees meeting on March 26 in order to write this update on behalf of Gen, who wasn't able to attend.

Shannon reported on the ILS migration project, web accessibility support for member libraries, the SCLS governance review work group's progress in getting input on how SCLS is governed, and her COSLA (Chief Officers of State Library Agencies) advocacy experience in Washington DC, as well as the news that Shannon just celebrated two years as the SCLS Director. The meeting agenda listed a demo of the discovery layer of the new integrated library system (library catalog), but the demo was moved to the April board meeting. Business at the meeting included the approval of the System's annual report. Shannon also shared Trustee Tale, a web page with resources for library trustees created by OWLS (Outagamie Waupaca Library System). I encourage you to check out the articles posted there, mostly created by Wisconsin Library System directors. At the next meeting (April 23), they'll be reviewing the Baker Tilly audit.
