SUMMARY:

Ben Anton and Rhonda Plourd briefly presented the project. They propose to use metal standing seam panels on three low pitched roofs (not the main roof). Richard Stone, not registered, made a comment that 1126 Spaight has a metal roof and in the winter, snow comes off the roof in one large sheet and can be potentially dangerous to pedestrians and adjacent homes (water damage in basement, etc.).
